Read: the assessment report (27.05.2014) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD(DVL) qualification against increased intake from 04 to 05 seats at Bangalore Medical College and Research Institute, Bangalore granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore.

1. Minutes of the last meeting of The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee – confirmation of.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee confirmed the minutes of The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee meeting held on 26th August, 2014.

The Committee has observed that there has been confusion in interpreting benefit of Defence Services experience to be given for appointment/promotion to teaching posts and eligibility of those holding DNB and P.G. Diploma Qualifications for appointment as Senior Resident/Assistant Professor. The P.G. Medical Education Committee, M.C.I., has decided to issue following classifications:-

1. Benefit of Defence Services Experience:

Defence Services Doctors who worked in following Hospitals upto 28.05.2003 as Graded Specialists, Classified Specialists or Advisor/Consultant would get teaching experience and their eligibility for appointment to various teaching posts would be as follows:-

96. Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore - Recognition of MD(Forensic Medicine/Forensic Medicine & Toxicology) qualification in respect of students being trained at Basaveswara Medical College and Hospital, Chitradurga - Karnataka.

Read: the Assessment Report (June, 2014) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD(Forensic Medicine/Forensic Medicine & Toxicology) qualification at Basaveswara Medical College and Hospital, Chitradurga granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (June, 2014) and decided to recommend not to recognize MD(Forensic Medicine/Forensic Medicine & Toxicology) qualification granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore in respect of students being trained at Basaveswara Medical College and Hospital, Chitradurga for 2(Two) seats because of the following facts:-

1. The number of post-mortems performed by the staff of the Institute are very few – 52 in 2011, 37 in 2012 & 80 in 2013.
2. Medico-Legal Examination only 2 cases in a year.
3. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Act, 1956.
