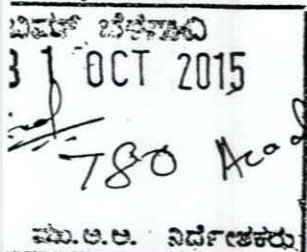

1. Minutes of the last meeting of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee – confirmation of.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee confirmed the minutes of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee meeting held on 14th July, 2015 with the following modification:

It was noted that in Item No. 120 (b) it was decided *“The Institution be informed about it and if they have not submitted, they may be asked to submit within a week.”* This decision was meant for colleges which has already paid the fee in previous year and wanted an adjustment, they could be asked to get the previously paid fee adjusted even after last date of submission of application. However, fresh applicant who has never paid the fee cannot be allowed to pay after the last date of submission of application and such applications be rejected. The necessary correction may be done and if action already taken may be modified accordingly and concerned Institution may be informed, accordingly.

6. Deficiency of Senior Residents: 2. Dr. C. Deepa is DMRD and Dr. Venkat Nageshwar is DMRD. Both are not eligible because they don't have 3 years teaching experience at the time of appointment.
7. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Admissions done (if any) against these seats after the first batch appeared in Examination till their recognition will be irregular, not in accordance with MCI regulations (notified with prior permission of Central Government on 21/07/2009) and will not be recognized. This is also clarified in the letter of permission granted u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 issued for these seats i.e. as per provisions of the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000, failure to seek timely recognition/ renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission against these postgraduate seats. In case, the college authorities desire to submit compliance, same should be received in this office preferably within six weeks of issue of this letter but definitely, prior to next admission so that the matter of recognition can be finally decided. If no compliance is received within this period or compliance/ compliance verification is found unsatisfactory, it will result in stoppage of admission to the postgraduate course against the above mentioned seats.

3. Unit A does not have any Asso. Prof. There are only 2 faculty in the Unit; hence it cannot be considered as PG Unit.
4. Unit B has only 2 faculty; hence it cannot be considered as PG Unit.
5. Resultantly, there is no Unit which can be considered as PG Unit.
6. Specialty clinics like Paediatric Haematology, Paediatric Nephrology & Paediatric Nephrology are not run.
7. Asthma & Thalassemia clinics are not available.
8. Paediatric Ventilator is not available.
9. Services like Dialysis, Parenteral Nutrition are not provided.

15. There is only 1 research publication from the department in indexed journals in last 3 years. Even this publication deals with knowledge & practice of menstruation in adolescent girls and does not deal with any Paediatric problem as such.
16. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.
